AGTV Years 4 to 9 Poetry Competition Secondary State Final Results 2023

Thirty years ago, the first AGTV State Final of the Poetry Competition was held for Year 8 and 9 students. That's 30 years of collaboration of teachers of German in facilitating this learning opportunity for students.

In 2023, the competition is for Years 4 to 9 in Regional Finals and 5 to 9 in State Finals for DaF and Open. And since 2022, a Group Performance section for recorded performances submitted for State Final judging.

This year, there were 16 Regional Finals for secondary students convened across regional and metropolitan Victoria; some remotely, some in person. Students competed for Gold, Silver and Bronze medals. A warm thanks to the Regional Final Coordinators for their work in facilitating a Regional Final. The Regional Finals were supported by the Victorian Government.

Our grateful thanks to the teachers for their support in providing the opportunity for students to participate in an authentic cultural practice of German-speaking communities.

The Secondary State Final was held on Saturday 26th August at the Austrian Club with 81 students attending with their families from regional and metropolitan Victoria.
