Any student whose first or second home language is German, or who are current or past students of a bilingual school must enter the OPEN section. AGTV Criteria	SCORE
<b>Pronunciation and Intonation</b> The words are pronounced correctly with confidence.	/ 10
<b>Diction and Phrasing</b> The phrases are distinct and appropriately emphasized e.g. tempo, stress, pauses.	/ 10
<b>Interpretation and Insight</b> How effectively the understanding of the mood and meaning of the poem is conveyed. This includes the overall tone and use of voice, eye contact and facial expressions. Limited gestures only if appropriate for a recitation to a German-speaking community.	/ 10

### AGTV Advice to the Judges

The AGTV criteria emphasise delivery i.e. use of voice and phrasing.  
Gestures only acceptable if they are natural for the poem and for an audience fluent in German.
